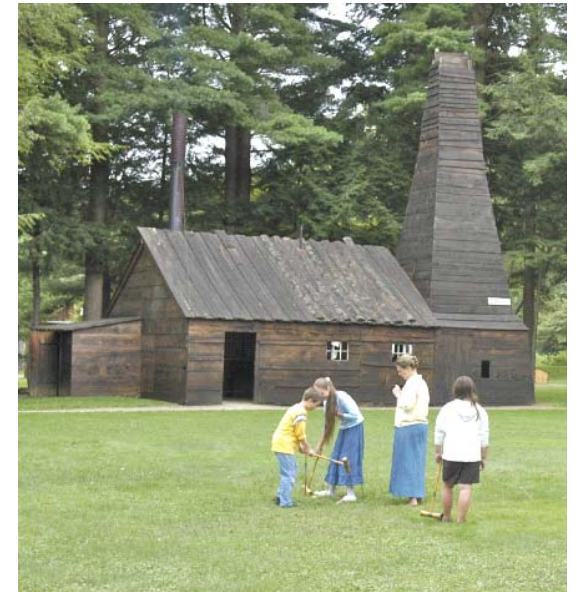

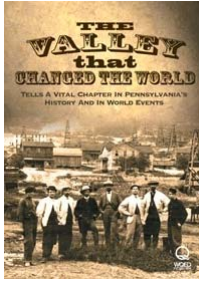

Coopers, Blacksmiths and Basket Weavers will be demonstrating their art, alternating throughout the day in the crafters corner 10 - 7.



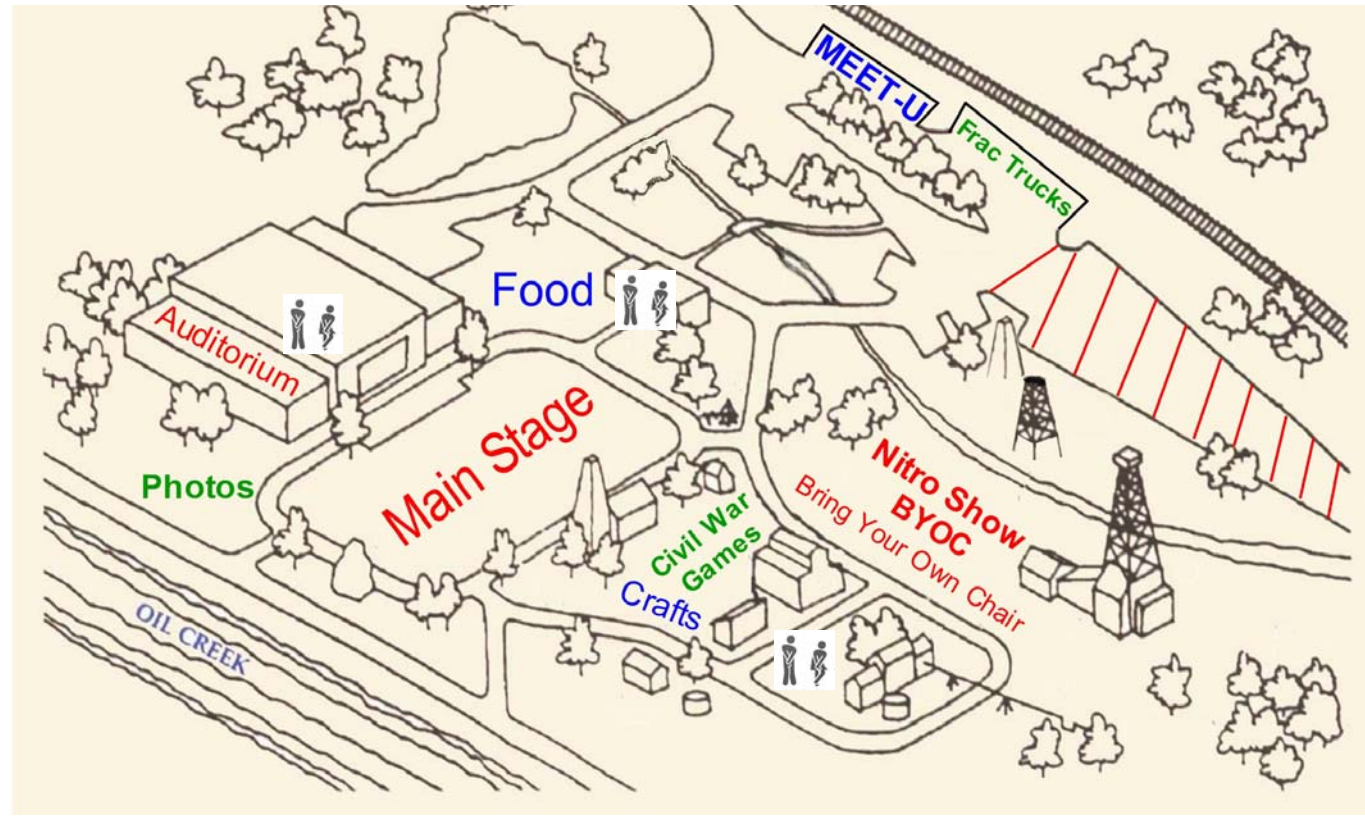
Civil War Encampment
