“Friends of Drake Well, Inc. to Host All-You-Can-Eat Pancake Breakfast”

On Saturday, March 24, Friends of Drake Well, Inc.’s innovative educational outreach program, MEET-U (Mobile Energy Education Training Unit), will host an all-you-can-eat pancake breakfast fundraiser. The event will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the Titusville YMCA Educational Building, 528 West Main Street, Titusville, PA. Diners may top their pancakes with fruit or syrup, and will also receive a side of sausage links and the choice of coffee or orange juice to drink. The cost is \$7.00 for adults (12+ years), \$3.00 for youth (6-11 years) and free for children 5 years and under.

All proceeds from the event will benefit the MEET-U educational outreach program.

Developed in 2009 as an educational partnership between Friends of Drake Well, Inc. and Drake Well Museum and Park, the MEET-U program features a 44’ exhibit trailer that travels throughout Pennsylvania, Ohio, New York and West Virginia, spreading awareness of energy creation, development and utilization. The goal of this outreach program is to educate school children and the public on the historic and modern uses of energy in an effort to improve the future of energy consumption. To date, over 150,000 people have visited the educational exhibits in the MEET-U trailer at schools, fairs, and other community events.

Located off Route 8 south of Titusville, Drake Well Museum and Park is open year round. Spring hours are Tuesday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday from noon to 5:00 p.m. Drake Well Museum is administered by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission in partnership with Friends of Drake Well, Inc. and is part of the Pennsylvania Trails of History® (www.PATrailsofHistory.com).
