“Drake Well Museum to Celebrate Pennsylvania’s 335th Birthday”

On Sunday, March 13, Drake Well Museum and Park will offer free admission in celebration of Pennsylvania’s Charter Day. A statewide celebration, Charter Day commemorates the founding of Pennsylvania through the 1681 Charter that King Charles II of Great Britain granted to William Penn.

In celebration of the 335th anniversary of the Penn Charter, Drake Well Museum and Park will be open from noon to 5:00 p.m. for visitors to view the exhibit gallery.

Located off Route 8 south of Titusville, Drake Well Museum and Park is open year round.
